

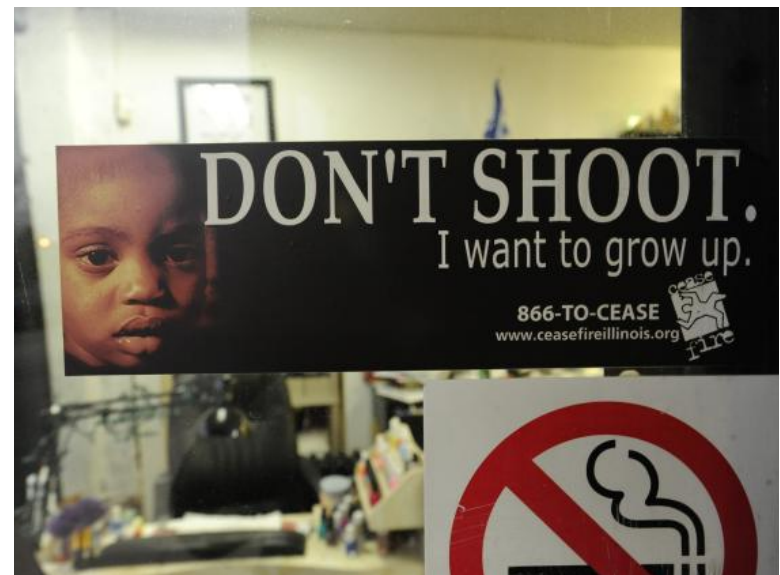
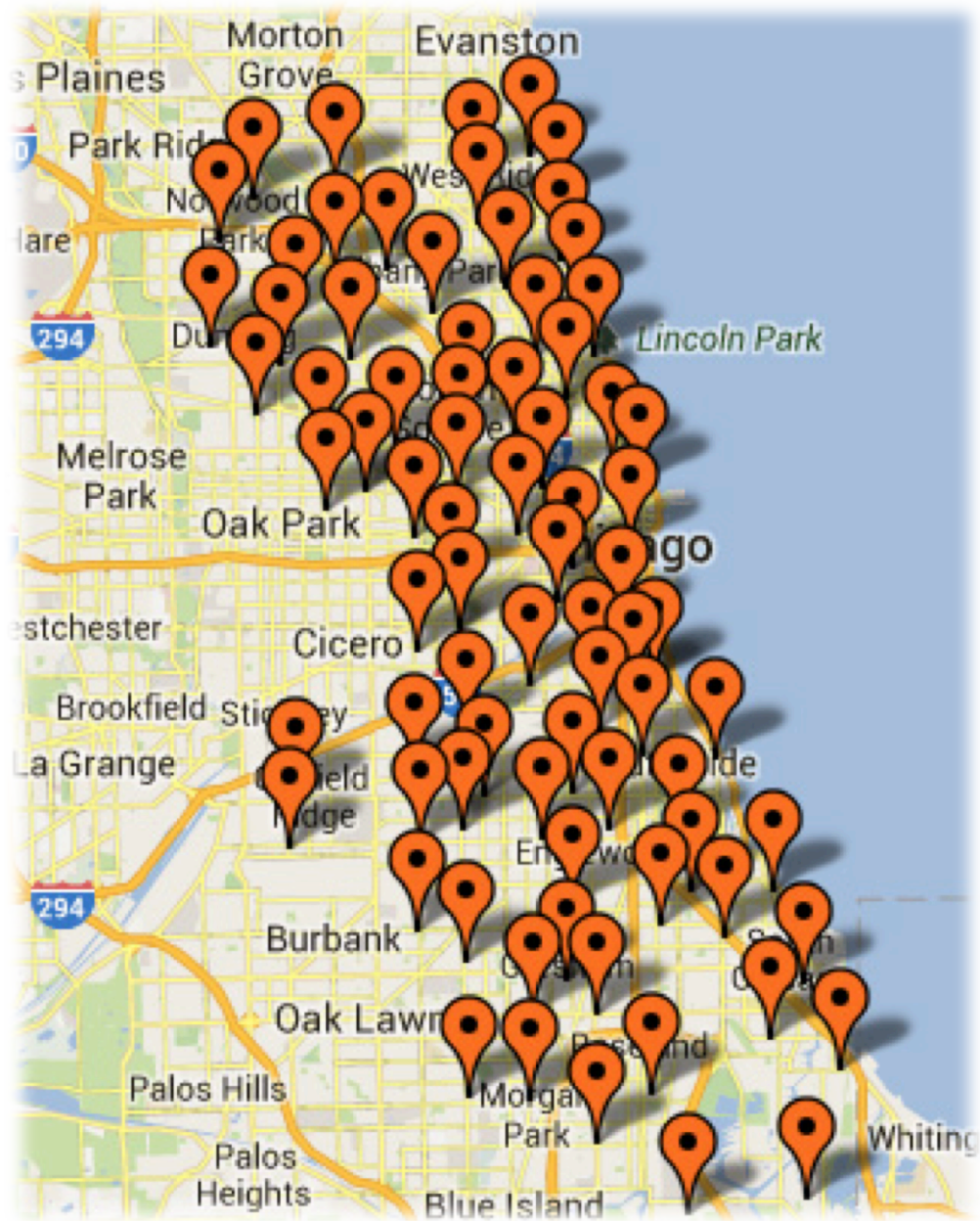

Executive summary

The Chicago Public Library will collaborate with community partners to create a unique learning environment that emphasizes physical creation and problem solving. CPL will use this space to test the notion that libraries can use the maker/hacker model (self-paced, hands on, collaborative) to foster the development of critical 21st century skills among our patrons

Project objective

Outcome

- Foster problem-solving, collaboration and creative skills among patrons
- Connect Chicagoans to growing community of creators and related education and employment
- Determine role of libraries in developing learning models based on maker movement

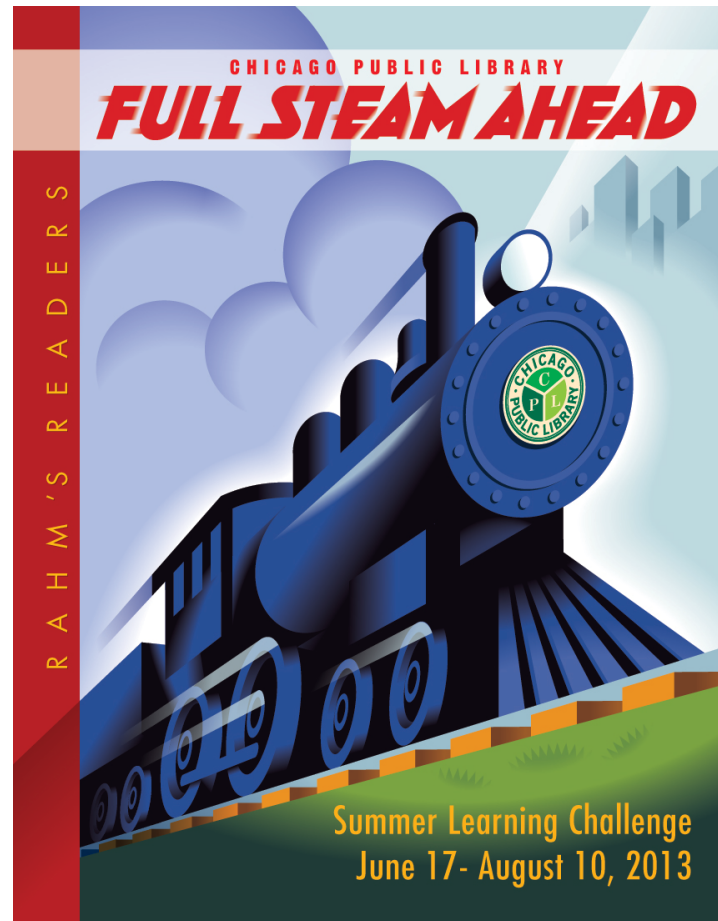
